

**Minutes of the Meeting held to discuss Annual Implementation Plan 2010-11  
under TSC of State of Goa in New Delhi on 6<sup>th</sup> April, 2010**

---

1. A meeting was held to discuss Annual Implementation Plan 2010-11 for TSC at 2.30 PM on 6<sup>th</sup> April, 2010 at 247, A-Wing, Nirman Bhawan, New Delhi. The Meeting was chaired by Secretary, Department of Drinking Water Supply. List of participants in annexed.

2. The gist of discussions held with the representatives of the State Govt. is as under :

**A. Achievement during 2009-10**

Goa presented the progress made under TSC as against the targets set by the State. The various initiatives taken by the State Government were presented prioritizing TSC in both Districts. The following steps were intimated to be taken by the State Government during the presentation:

- TSC Programme is reviewed by Chief Secretary on regular basis.
- VWSC constituted in GPs to monitor TSC programme.
- 1 Day Workshop was conducted for all the VWSC members in all the 11 Talukas to impress upon the importance of TSC.
- Various stakeholders like PWD, BDOs, Panchayats, Social Welfare, DRDA, W&CD have joined together to make TSC successful in Goa state.
- Base Line Survey in all the 189 GPs is undertaken through BDOs. Report to be ready in 60 days.
- Efforts are being made to obtain NOCs from Private Owners for construction of Toilets for Anganwadis. 154 NOCs are already obtained.
- Construction of Toilets for Anganwadis wherever NOCs obtained is being initiated.
- IEC Activities for both the Districts is being scaled up.

Secretary, PWD, Govt. of Goa informed that State Govt. is implementing Scheme of providing "**FREE TOILETS**" to SC/ST/ OBC category households from 1984 onwards. Under this till date, 85480 Individual House Hold Toilets have been constructed through state funds through Sulabh International, an NGO. Present cost of these toilets is to the tune of Rs.22000/- per unit. Secretary(DWS) suggested that State should use Central funds in convergence with state govt scheme and report in online monitoring system.

achievements of IHHLs in District MPR and Panchayat MPR which needs to be updated.

**(ii) Coverage of all school and anganwadi with toilet facilities:** The state must immediately chalk out a plan for full coverage of all school and anganwadis with toilet facilities as per TSC guidelines and construct the toilet units within the first quarter of 2010-11.
